Her brilliant partner was dead within six weeks of a diagnosis of bipolar disorder, leaving his nine-year-old daughter and wife without so much as a note to explain his actions, a plan to help them recover from their grief, or a solution for the hundreds of thousands of dollars in debt that they would inherit from him. *All the Things We Never Knew* takes readers from David and Sheila's romance through the last three months of their life together and into the year after his death.
